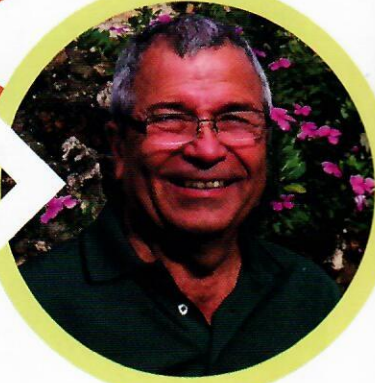

WE ASKED LAKE NORMAN WOMEN TO GLOAT ABOUT WHAT MAKES THEIR HUSBANDS FANTASTIC:

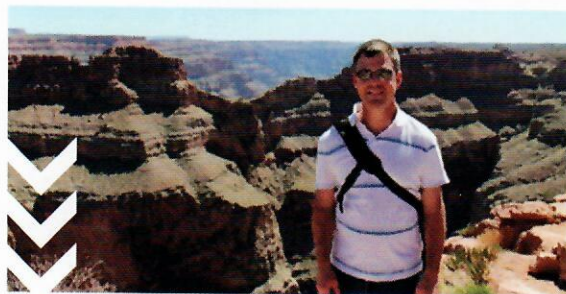
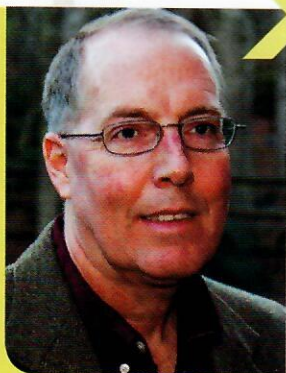
DANA GINGRAS: *Wife, Lynne Gingras*
